REDISCOVERING THE ART OF LIVING AND DYING: PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS JUNE 6 AND 7. Medically assisted death in Canada is becoming the 'new normal', with people now planning their deaths as they do other milestones in their lives. However, the medicalization of human suffering and death present those living and exploring their Christian faith with new challenges to justice and care, particularly for the most vulnerable among us. A physician, bioethicist and a Sister of Charity, Sr. Nuala Kenny offers a unique perspective through lenses of both medical science and Christian faith. In Rediscovering the Art of Living and Dying, Sr. Kenny will share the facts, traditions, teachings, issues and choices involved in medically-assisted dying to support individuals on their own rediscovery of living and dying. Sr. Kenny will speak on June 6, at 7pm at St Joseph Church, Port Hawkesbury, and June 7 at 7pm at St John the Baptist Church, New Glasgow. Both presentations are open to the public.
