WORLD DAY OF THE SICK: Today, February 11th, Feast of Our Lady of Loudres is World Day of the Sick established by Pope John Paul II in 1993, the year he was diagnosed with Parkinson's disease. The ministry of Jesus to the sick is central to the life of the Church. It reminds us that service to the sick and suffering cannot be neglected. It recognizes the great efforts of doctors, nurses, health care institutions and pastoral care givers to restore health to those afflicted with illness and death.
