Donations to the Men’s Shelter: The CWL had a guest speaker Mr. Jerry Marsh from the Men’s Shelter in Sydney address the meeting. It was a very informative session and gave us a look from the inside of the organization as to the needs and help that is provided to these individuals less fortunate than many. On any given day, there could be as many as 150 homeless individuals in the Sydney area. Regardless of their situation, no one is turned away and most of the time they arrive with only the clothes on their back. Some of the clients are fortunate to get an apartment with the assistance available but they are in need of everything from clothing, personal hygiene products, sneakers, kitchen items, bedding, towels, furniture etc. Mr. Marsh also said they also need back packs for those who will be leaving the shelter with the few items they are given to help them out. As we look around home and see items we no longer use or need perhaps we could pack them up and bring them to the back of the church and the CWL will look after getting them to the shelter. On behalf of the CWL I would like to thank you for your continued support in helping with this worthwhile cause.
