**REMEMBRANCE DAY SERVICES, BADDECK:** Remembrance Day Ecumenical Service will be at Knox at 9:30 a.m. Remembrance Day Ecumenical Service at Farquharson Memorial Presbyterian Church – 2 p.m. There will a short service of Remembrance at Ephraim Scott Church, South Haven – 8:30 a.m. **BELLS OF PEACE: UNIFIED ACTION OF REMEMBRANCE** on November 11, honouring Fallen Canadians in WWI. On November 11, 2018, 100 years will have passed since the signing of the armistice that officially ended WWI. As a tribute to all Canadians that served in this horrific struggle, the Royal Canadian Legion is calling for a unified action of remembrance for those from that era—an event that allows Canadians, if only for a moment, to stop, to remember and to feel, perhaps for a second, the joy that peace brought after so much death and destruction. In order to achieve this, the Legion is asking churches all across the country to ring their bells 100 times at sunset on November 11, 2018. The hope is all who hear the bells will stop and focus on the loss and sacrifice both on the battlefield and at home. The churches of Baddeck are participating in this event. Bells will commence ringing at 5:07 pm on Sunday evening, November 11.
