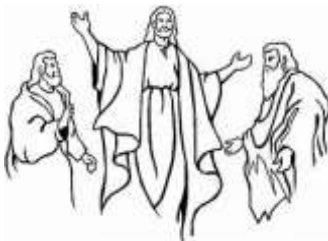

UPDATE FROM FR. PAUL: I remain grateful to God and all those who have been with me in Prayer and now I am able to report that my last PET Scan showed that the cancer has not spread to other areas of my body. The original cancer has returned but is limited to one area, and already I have begun tests in preparation for the start of treatment on this cancer. I will be having 30 sessions of radiation which means 5 days a week for 6 weeks. At the same time I will be receiving some Chemotherapy, but at this time I do not know how much. There is a team of health professionals who look at my case and they decide the full plan. This should be settle in the next two to three weeks. Obviously I hadn't imagined that all this would be unfolding when I was first diagnosed with lung cancer over a year ago, and maybe it is a good thing that we cannot see into the future. While I find this whole process somewhat overwhelming at times, when I take it in small chunks at a time it is much more manageable. I continue to be grateful to family, friends and so many of you for your ongoing support, understanding and prayers during this experience. I will let you know when the treatment begins as we continue to walk together in this cancer experience.

PRAYING FOR FR. PAUL: Recently Fr. Paul began a nice tradition of saying The Hail Mary after the Prayers for the Faithful. Let us continue this in his honour asking The Blessed Mother to grant him a speedy recovery and many years of good health as he continues to bring joy to our hearts, homes and communities.

ROSARY: In keeping with October being the month of the Holy Rosary, it will be prayed at Holy Rosary Church, Washabuck, at 2 p.m. on Sunday, October 28, special intention being the healing and health of Fr.
