<u>Office Hours</u> - For now the office will be open four days per week instead of the usual five days on: *Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday 8:30 am to12:30 pm*.

<u>Need Box Envelopes</u> – People calling looking for envelopes are invited to use the hall envelopes for now, until we can get the envelopes. Tax receipts still given.

<u>Boxes of Envelopes</u> — People are asked to retrieve their church envelopes by the end of January at the entrance of the Church, then they will be available in the office for pick up. In February some unused envelope numbers may need to be reassigned for those seeking a box of envelopes. Each year the church spends over \$2300. on these boxed envelopes, but we can reduce that amount by cleaning up the parish database.
