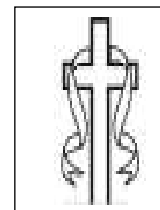
In loving memory of our parents, Austin and Eileen Fyfe and their great granddaughter, Kimberly Elizabeth.

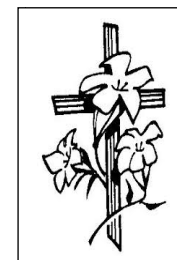

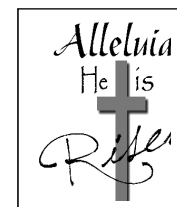
