He is, therefore, set apart for divine worship and the service of the Church. The Bishop's Appointment as Coadjutor Archbishop - On July 5, Bishop Dunn assumed the position of Coadjutor Archbishop for the Archdiocese of Halifax-Yarmouth. At that time, he became the Apostolic Administrator for the Diocese of Antigonish and will continue in that position until a new bishop is named and installed here in this Diocese (the nuncio believes that this will happen by the end of the year). Practically speaking, he shall continue with all commitments here in the Diocese over the next few months. Gradually (in August and in the Fall) he will become more involved in the Archdiocese. From the time that he assumes the office of Coadjutor Archbishop, the Diocese is vacant and until the time that a new Bishop is installed, priests will pray for "our Administrator, Brian" in the Eucharistic Prayer. Please continue to pray for him as he takes on this new position.
