NEW HORIZON ADDICTION REHAB TREATMENT CENTER: The Center is in Sydney. It is an affordable private 12 bed treatment center offering 45-day co-ed residential treatment programming. The facility offers acute detoxification, stabilization and after care programs for those struggling with opioid, alcohol, benzodiazepine, cocaine or other substance use disorders. The program focuses on providing evidence based and strengths-based treatment programming including a mix of psycho-educational treatment, 12 step programs, CBT, group therapy and individual counseling as well as evidence-based medication assisted treatment, including methadone or suboxone. Highly trained and dedicated staff of physicians, nurses, counselors and administrative staff, guide and support patients and their families through each step toward mental, physical, spiritual and social well-being. The program operates 7 days per week and is structured to provide individualized treatment family support and programming to support the resident. Integrated throughout the program schedule are therapeutic activities focused on individual physical and spiritual regeneration. These activities focus on self-discovery and reconnecting with one's self, with one's community and with the world around them.
