**Good Friday:** Service of the Lord's Passion – 3:00 p.m. – Universal Day of Fast & Abstinence from meat. We fast today and tomorrow to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare to share deeply in the joy of his resurrection

**Holy Saturday:** Sacrament of Reconciliation from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Solemn Easter Vigil – 8:30 p.m. – On Holy Saturday, the people of God remain in prayer and fasting at the tomb of the Lord, meditating on his sufferings, death, and descent to the dead. Throughout this day, we are invited to continue the solemn paschal fast which began on Good Friday. During the solemn vigil service, a night of prayer looks forward to the celebration of the Lord's resurrection. Morning will give way to the joys of Eastertide which we will celebrate for the next 50 days.
