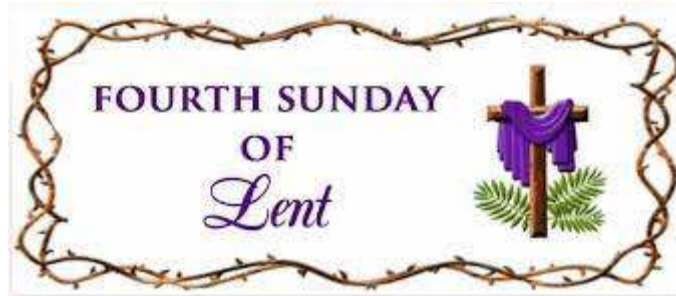


# HOLY ROSARY PARISH - WESTMOUNT, NS
