**TRUTH & RECONCILIATION:** In the follow up to Pope Francis' visit to the Indigenous Peoples of Canada, the work of reconciliation continues. The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops agreed to establish a \$ 30 million National Reconciliation Fund to support and advance healing and reconciliation initiatives for Indigenous People. The Diocese of Antigonish has committed to raising revenue for this fund over the next five years in relation with the Diocese of Yarmouth-Halifax. The funds collected in Nova Scotia will be used to support local projects and programs to promote education and healing. The first collection will be the weekend of September 24<sup>th</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup>.

**WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR CREATION:** September 1<sup>st</sup> is extended to October 4<sup>th</sup>, the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi. This month is designated by Pope Francis to focus on the damage being done to our planet and to focus on what we can do to stop the trend.
