

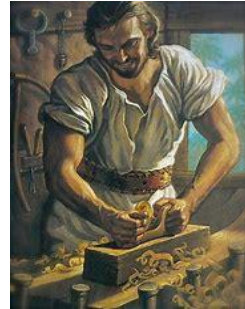

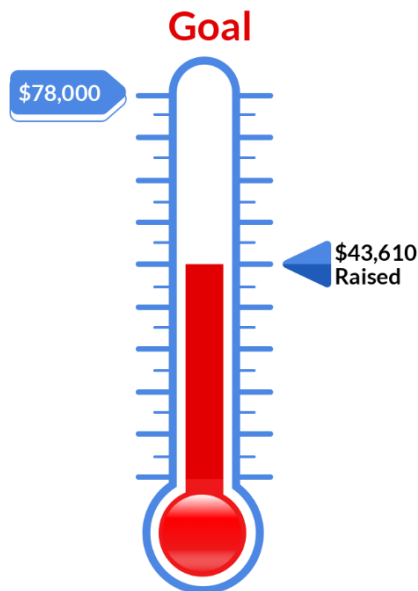

Please bring your own chair to the cemetery mass on Sunday July 17th at 10am at Holy Cross Cemetery.

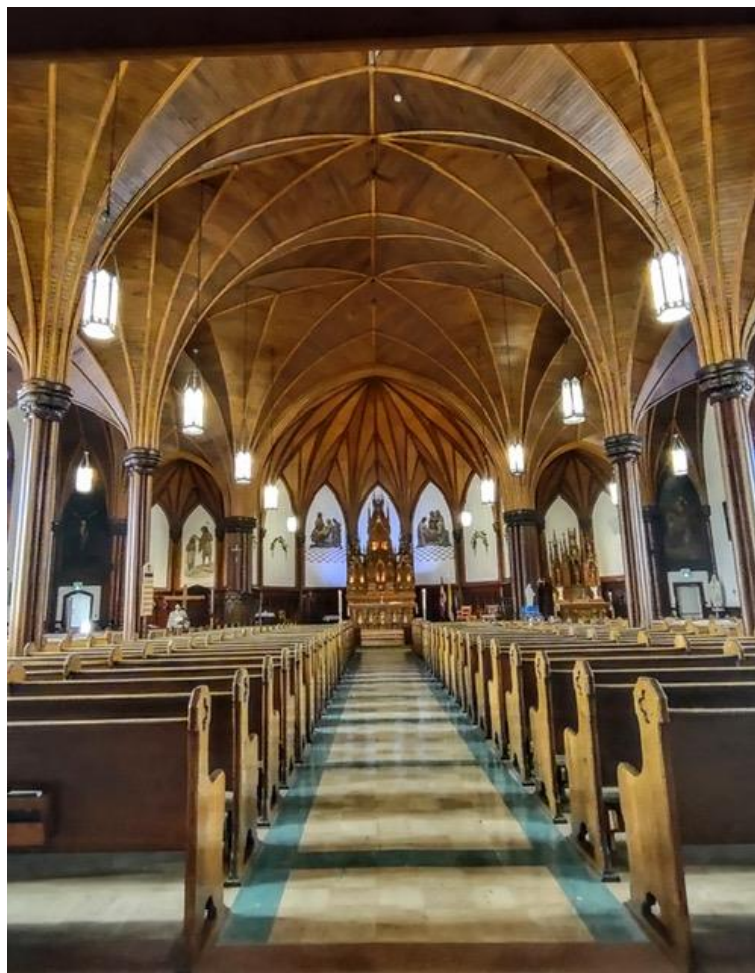
Baby Food Fund

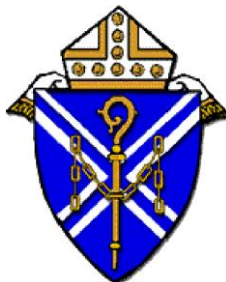
