



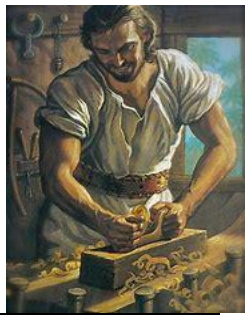

PARISH NEWS

Mass on this weekend – YES. After lots of preparations, we are ready to upgrade and have a full mass this weekend, thus mass will take place this weekend at church: Sat. 4 pm and Sun. 10 am.

Please observe the **physical distancing** paint (outside) and tape (inside) that is on the ground to ensure you stay 6 feet from others. You will find these paint markings on the stairs and ramp as you approach the church and then tape inside throughout the church to guide you during Holy Communion.

You will be welcomed by a greeter who must take basic contact information, then you can walk to the left (choir side) or the right (tabernacle side), but must now remain seated on that side of the church. After sanitizing your hands, collection option, an usher will assist you to a seat of your choice on that side. Please wait to be guided by the usher.

Bubbles – People living in the same household can sit in a pew together, otherwise individuals are asked to sit in their own pew. However, there are two seats per pew, therefore if individuals arrive first, they must move to the inside of the pew to leave space

for the next person. White ribbons section off our pews and we enter and exit the same side.

Holy Communion – People sitting on the tabernacle side of the church will receive on that side, while those seated on the choir side will receive on the choir side. Place your hands under the barrier for communion.

After mass, people can exit any door they wish, with physical distancing. Afterwards the church will be disinfected.
